### **Agreement for school**

The school will do its best to:

- Encourage children to do their best at all times.
- Expect the best from children in behaviour and work.
- Inform parents and carers regularly how their children are progressing.
- Inform children, parents and carers what the teachers aim to teach the children each term.
- Take reasonable steps to ensure the safety, happiness and self-confidence of all children.
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents and carers to become involved in the daily life of the school.
- Set, mark and monitor home tasks regularly in keeping with the school's policy.
- Contact parents and carers as soon as possible if we are concerned about their child's work or behaviour.
- Contact parents and carers if there is a persistent problem concerning their child's attendance or punctuality.
- Offer a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of our children.

### **Agreement for pupils**

I will do my best to:

- Treat adults and other pupils with respect
- Work hard in class and allow others to work
- Respect and follow the agreed class and school rules
- Look after other people in the school
- Report bullying or any accident or other incident
- Remember safety rules and good manners when using the internet
- Take messages home
- Look after the school environment
- Complete homework tasks and home reading when they are set

### **Agreement for parents/carers**

To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

- Make sure that my child arrives in school on time and is collected on time.
- Make sure that my child attends school regularly and inform the school of the reason for any absence.
- Support the school in maintaining good behaviour and to help my child understand and follow the school behaviour charter.
- Behave in a way that sets children a good example when I am on school premises.
- Support my child with homework and other home learning opportunities.
- Read to and with my child frequently.
- Attend parent evenings.
- Ensure that my child wears the school uniform and follows the school dress code.
- Let school know if there are any problems that may affect my child's ability to learn.
- To make sure the school always has an up-to-date emergency contact number and to keep my child at home when unwell.
- To comply with the school's safeguarding policy and update records to include designated adults who are responsible for the drop-off and collection of your child.
