# HISTORY – The Aztecs KNOWLEDGE BANK:

 A civilization that lived during 14th to the 16th centuries in Tenochtitlan, a city built on an island in Lake Texcoco (now known - Mexico City)



- Aztecs were polytheistic worshipped a large number of gods each one looked after a different part of Aztec life – some were more significant than others
- The Aztecs are estimated to have sacrificed 20,000 people a year, and more than four times that when a particularly revered temple was built
- Appeasing the gods guaranteed a more prosperous future, whereas playing sports and indulging in arts was a way to develop comradery and appreciation of skills
