

Summer Reading Challenge 2023

The Summer Reading Challenge is a great way to encourage four to 11-year-olds to keep reading books over the summer and help them boost their reading skills, ready for a return to school.

This year's theme is Ready, Set, Read! a Challenge that has been co-designed by the Youth Sports Trust to help keep children active over the summer holiday.

To help you promote the Challenge to your students we would like to:

Offer you a virtual assembly package that your staff could deliver

Where possible, arrange a special assembly visit from a member of library staff or a library volunteer – this could be virtual or physical – please get in touch to ask about our availability

If you're new to the Summer Reading Challenge, it is:

An annual event which aims to keep children aged 4 - 11 actively reading over the summer

It keeps your pupils reading over the summer, ready for their return to school in the autumn, and supports the successful transition between year groups and key stages

In 2022 86% of adults agreed that the Challenge improved their child's reading skills and 77% of children said they learnt a new fact, or found a new favourite story or a new favourite author

How it works:

It's totally FREE to take part

Children can sign up in North Somerset Libraries, including the Mobile Library, from Saturday 8 July

If they read any 6 library books of their choice, they will collect a smelly sticker per book

If they complete the challenge by Saturday 9 September, they will receive a certificate and medal whilst stocks last
