

Over the past week or so, Mrs Seel and the SAS Club children have been having lots of fun at Sandford After Schoolers, as they have been taking part in some activities from #30dayswild. Wiltshire Wildlife Trust is calling on everyone to take on the 30 Days Wild challenge by doing one simple, wild thing each day throughout the month of June.

30 Days Wild is the UK's biggest nature challenge run by The Wildlife Trusts and kindly supported by players of People's Postcode Lottery. The annual challenge invites people of all ages to connect with nature every single day for an entire month. Over two million people have taken part over the last nine years, with more than 500,000 people taking on the challenge last year alone.

Popular activities include wildlife-watching, eating outdoors, planting wildflower seeds and listening to birdsong. Other favourite pastimes included bug-hunting, fruit-picking, growing plants and flowers, exploring a nature reserve, creating a mini pond or going on a river walk. As you can see, the children have enjoyed some varied activities outside, such as making a mini pond, hugging trees and much more! HELP AND SUPPORT FOR OUR FAMILIES

We have been advised by North Somerset Council of the following, which may be of help to our families. Please follow the links below for further information:

Tax Free Childcare (also referred to as TFC)

Tax-Free Childcare is a government scheme to support working parents with childcare costs. Eligible parents set up an online childcare account which they can use to pay you directly. For every £8 parents pay in, the government will pay an extra £2. Parents can get up to £2,000 per child per year, or £4,000 for disabled children.

Parents can use Tax-Free Childcare to pay for:

- Registered childminders, nurseries and nannies
- Registered after-school clubs and play schemes
- Home care workers working for a registered home care agency

Parents can find out more and apply via Childcare Choices.

Parents can also apply for Tax-Free Childcare if they're not working but expect to start a new job in the next 31 days. They can't get Tax-Free Childcare and Tax Credits, Universal Credit or childcare youchers at the same time.


