We are delighted to inform you that we have secured a booking for our Year 6 residential trip to Barton Hall, Torquay which is a PGL site – please see website for further information regarding this venue:-

The cost, which has been significantly subsided to help families in the current cost of living crisis, will be £262.50 per person and for any pupil who is in receipt of free school meals, this can be further subsidised from your £150 allocation towards extracurricular activities. Consent and payments are via ParentPay where you have the option to pay in full or in three instalments of £87.50 (to help spread the cost, with final payment due by 24^{th} May.

There will be further updates regarding items for the trip e.g. bedding/clothing etc. in due course, in a 'Presentation to Parents'.
