


World Book Day takes place on **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024** and we hope you'll join us as we come together to encourage every child in school to be a reader and love books.

To celebrate World Book Day, we will be running lots of fun activities throughout the week with a theme of WHERE THE WILD THINGS ARE! The children will be listening to this classic book in the lead up to Book Week, with their class teachers.



# **Drama Group**

To kick the week off, we have invited 'Bringing Books to Life', drama & dance group, to hold a Where The Wild Things Are workshop with every class on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March. This will require a **small charge of £4.70 per pupil** payable on ParentPay. *If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, their funding will cover this cost.*

We would like to encourage pupils and staff to dress up as a 'Wild Thing' on THURSDAY 7<sup>th</sup> MARCH. Or, if you'd prefer to dress up or decorate an item to be something from your favourite book instead, that is fine too. You could draw your favourite character and attach it to your top or copy your favourite book cover on to a paper plate or turn a wooden spoon or toilet roll into a book character – whatever you want to do!
