Information for parents and children

Thank you for your interest in the overnight outdoor adventure. Here is some basic information for you. Please contact your school with any questions.

Venue: Fernhill farm, Compton Martin, BS40 6LD

Including campground, farm animals, woodland, open play space, and toilets.

Service provider: Osprey Outdoors Community Interest Company.

Osprey Outdoors employs experienced trainers to provide outdoor based activities for all ages. All staff undergo DBS Disclosure checks and has a strong history of providing safe and suitable activities for children and young people.

Overview:

An outdoor adventure incorporating activities, games, challenges and an overnight stay in tents. School will provide staff to supervise in correct adult/child ratios and act as assistants on some activities.

Transport: A 9.15am pick up from school with school staff to oversee. Arriving at Fernhill Farm for 10am by coach or minibus. Students can be collected from the side farm entrance the following day between 8.30 and 9am.

Entrance off the B3134:

Make sure to close the relevant gates.

Please do not drive to the farm buildings - you will end up in the wrong field.

Food: Individuals to provide own packed lunch for day 1. The evening meal and day 2 breakfast covered by Osprey Outdoors. Drinks and fruit will be served throughout the day

Likely itinerary: Activities to include some of the following:

- The legendary Fernhill Farm assault course









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Kit List:

Torch Wash Kit + Face Towel Warm Clothes (day and night) Clothes to cover legs (some activities in longer grass) Sleeping Bag + pillow Roll mat or suitable other (no lilo's please) Waterproofs (anorak or waterproof coat, waterproof trousers,) Plate, bowl, knife, fork, spoon, cup, tea towel Appropriate footwear for physical activity (to include field walking) Wellies (can wear these on the day to save space) 1 spare pair trainers or other suitable footwear Medication Packed lunch for day 1 and a few snacks Teddy bear Extra socks and undies. Warm hat for evening time Coat Sun hat and sun cream Carrier bag for dirty clothes A book to read before bed if you wish.

Important Notes:

- Please don't bring too much, the coach can only take so much and extra big bags take up all the tent space
- Please do **label absolutely everything**. There is a high probability that it may get lost if you don't.
- We will be outdoors on a farm, you WILL NOT need your best clothes or shoes. You WILL get dirty, so dress in a way that means you are warm and so that you can have the most fun without worrying about your clothes!
- We are on the Mendip hills, in England. Weather is unpredictable. Please bring at least a waterproof coat or anorak.





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
